I. INTRODUCTION

This document is a template for Microsoft Word versions 6.0 or later. If you are reading a paper version of this document, the EMAN 2007 conference secretary will be happy to provide you upon request with the electronic file so you can use it to prepare your manuscript.

II. 1 PAGE ABSTRACT / 5 PAGE CONFERENCE PAPER

Both the one page abstract and the five page conference paper should contain the title of the paper, the authors and their affiliation, a short abstract, the main contents of the paper, and a list of references. The manuscript must be submitted as a PDF document to the email address eman2007@cc.hut.fi. Please do not encrypt the PDF file.

III. MAIN DATES

Please submit your abstract by January 31st, 2007. After you have been notified of the acceptance of your abstract, the deadline for the conference paper is April 30th, 2007.

IV. FONT FORMAT

The text should be typed in Times New Roman font on A4 sheets, single spacing, two-column format. Margins are 25mm above, 15mm below and 20mm on the right and on the left. Please do not number the pages.

A. Equation format

Equations are referred by their number (1), and are aligned to centre. Equation 1 is an example of equation.

$$\int_0^2 F(r, \varphi) dr d\varphi = [\sigma r_2 / (2\mu_0)]. \quad (1)$$

B. Table and Figure format

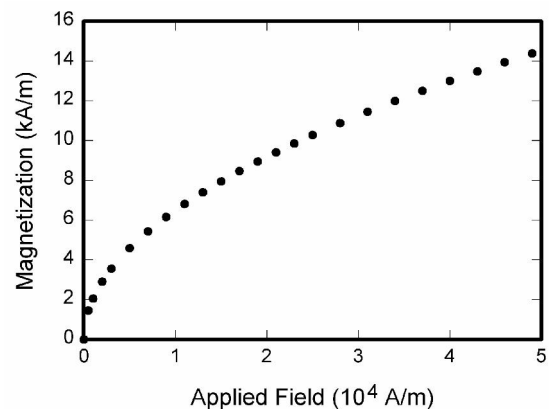


FIGURE 1: MAGNETIZATION AS A FUNCTION OF APPLIED FIELD.

Table 1 is an example of table and summarizes the used font sizes. Figure 1 is an example of figure. Tables and Figures should be numbered 1, 2, 3 and so forth. Their titles should be aligned to centre.
