The aim of the EMA-Net is to boost the implementation and use of Environmental Management Accounting (EMA) in the Nordic and Baltic countries. EMA includes accounting of environmental loads and costs, and thus contributes to both environmental and cost efficiency of companies.

EMA-Net focuses on:

- Providing training for the development of sound information systems that link accounting data with environmental monitoring systems
- Promoting the role of accounting (and accountants) in environmental management
- Exchanging experiences from national case studies
- Facilitating external reporting requirements
- Ensuring auditable data quality for key non-financial environmental performance indicators and their related costs
